Spectator FAQ's

Is there a fee to attend the event?

- There is a per vehicle fee to enter the park is \$5 for Marion County residents and \$6 for all others. Once inside the park, there is no fee to enter the spectator viewing area.

Where should I park?

- There will be limited parking in the park. Spectators are encouraged to park at the Mary & John Geisse Soccer fields located at 7225 W 56th St, Indianapolis, IN 46254. Please allow a minimum of 30 minutes to park and walk to the venue. ADA parking is available with a state issued hang tag or license plate inside the park.

Can I visit the team area?

- Spectators will not be allowed to enter the team area during racing.

Will there be merchandise for sale at the event?

- Big Ten Championship t-shirts will be for sale in the spectator viewing area. Please note it will be CASH ONLY!

Can I bring my regatta/tailgate setup to the championships?

- Tents are permitted in the spectator viewing area but must remain behind the tent setback line designated by markings on the ground. You may drop off your tent anytime after 5:00 pm. It is a public park and anything left unattended is left at your own risk.

Where will the awards ceremony take place?

- The awards ceremony will take place at the IRC boathouse. Spectators will walk to the awards area at the boathouse after the racing has completed. There will be ADA parking at the Beach Parking Lot for viewing the races and ADA parking at the boathouse for viewing the awards ceremony.

Are Dogs permitted in the spectator area?

- Yes, Dogs are allowed as long as they are on a leash.
