Executive Director Report Discussion – Angelia Thorpe

- Dashboard
 - Outreach: Went from yellow to green because summer camps, regattas, and adaptive programs are planned.



- Fundraising, still yellow
- Facilities yellow because of docks
- Masters: growing membership, still figuring out how to transition Learn to row to masters.

Management/Operations

- Insurance increased 22% from last year. They are dropping our coverage of starting docks because of theft. We are looking into cameras to monitor the docks.
- Fund development: submitted grant to Lilly through Indiana Sports Corporation. We raised \$30,000 for the cement pad, still needing the bulk of \$316,192 from Lilly Endowment.

- Events

- Completed a successful Indy Indoor Sprints. We made a profit and attracted more out of state clubs.
- In the process of gathering quotes to create a budget for US Rowing for Master's Nationals.
- The Events committee will be meeting bi-weekly to plan for all our events.
- Will need to start scheduling launch driver training.
- Going through the Master's Nationals contract, still lots of questions and will get answers.

Programs

- Spring enrollment is great with 92 enrolled in the high school program and 50 in middle school. We are looking to hire one more coach. There are 14 new rowers.
- Masters have 35 enrolled.
- Learn to row great response, 28 enrolled. May is full and June has 5 spots left.
- Adaptive program starts in May.
- Exploring the Stem to Stern program to partner with middle school, they go to stem class and then they come to IRC. We would reach out to underserved communities. Transportation and swimming lessons will be the biggest issues.
- Working on 2023 clinics calendar for Big Brother Big Sister, RHI, etc.

Janet has a document that lists all the committees and the members. She will pass this out. Denise volunteered to help with outreach. April 16th is volunteer appreciation week.
