Swim Test

In accordance with USRowing safety guidelines, all IRC rowers (members and juniors), must pass a swim test. No rower will be allowed on the water in an IRC boat unless they have completed the swim test and submitted the signed form to the coach. Without a completed swim test, participants must wear a life vest. Once completed, a form will remain on file for 6 years. This form is to be completed by a certified Lifeguard.



The swim test consists of:

- Demonstrating the ability to float and/or tread water for ten minutes. Dressed in typical rowing gear i.e. shirt & shorts.
- Putting on a PFD while in the water while floating

Take this form to any pool with a certified lifeguard on duty. Ask the guard to observe that you can do the tasks listed above. Bring the completed form to IRC before 1st on the water practice.
