Athlete & Spectator FAQs

Where should I park?

- THERE IS VERY limited parking inside the venue which will be for boats and athletes.
 We strongly suggest carpooling. The Athletes will have limited parking in the Upper Beach parking lot, and 56th street gatehouse parking lot.
- Spectators must park at the Mary and John Giess Soccer Field directly across the street from the park. There is a \$1.00 per person fee to walk into the park. Credit cards are accepted but exact change is helpful to keep the line moving. Please allow a minimum of 30 minutes to walk from your car to the venue.
- ADA parking spaces are available in the lower beach parking lot.

Is there a fee to attend the event?

• There is a fee to enter the park, of \$6 for Marion County residents and \$7 for all others if driving in and \$1 if walking in from the Mary and John Geisse Soccer f. Once inside the park, there is no fee to enter the spectator viewing area.

Will there be merchandise for sale at the event?

Can I bring my regatta/tailgate setup to the regatta?

 Tents are permitted in the spectator viewing area but must remain behind the tent setback line designated by markings on the ground.
